#### Fall 2020

The transfer students of Fall 20 included 254 students who entered the University in Summer 2020. Demographically, nearly sixty-seven percent (170) of the new transfer students are female, and sixty percent (170) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with Baptist religious affiliation make up eighteen percent (45) of the group.

For students with known addresses, 29.4% have Texas as their state of permanent address. Eighty percent of the students are U.S. citizens. Sixty-seven percent transferred from Texas colleges, with 5% coming from an in-state four-year institution and 52% from an in-state two-year school.

Twenty-two percent of students declared a major in Nursing, while fifteen percent declared Psychology
